

*The Lansing Area Ministry of Bells (LAMB), under the direction of Jane C. Wright, will present its 25th Annual Spring Ring on Saturday, March 7, 2009, at 4:30 p.m. at Waverly High School's gymnasium (on Snow Road between Michigan Ave. and W. St. Joseph in west Lansing). This facility is handicapper-accessible.*

*Jane C. Wright, who founded LAMB and the Capital City Ringers in 1984, is returning to the podium to conduct this year's Spring Ring celebration. Although she moved to Kalamazoo several years ago to become the Director of Worship and Fine Arts Ministries at Westwood United Methodist Church, she continues to direct the Capital City Ringers. Mrs. Wright has conducted many massed ringing events and has served as the Area V Secretary for the American Guild of English Handbell Ringers (AGEHR) and as a clinician at Area V festival-conferences. For many years prior to her move to Kalamazoo, she was the Director of Music and Fine Arts Ministries at Mt. Hope United Methodist Church in Lansing.*

*The theme of the concert is "Ringing Through the Year--A Celebration of Church Seasons" and handbell arrangements of music of the church year (Epiphany, Lent, Easter, Pentecost, Advent, and Christmas) will be featured. About 200 ringers from 20 choirs will join together for massed ringing; solo numbers will also be played. The concert is free and open to the public. A freewill offering will be taken.*
