High treble ringers, please note the doubling of the upstemmed melody notes in measures 59 to 66 and measures 105 to 108. This is optional, if you are able to ring cleanly.

There are some printing errors: measure 21, beat 2 is an A-natural 4; measure 106, beat 2 is an A-natural 5 and an A-natural 6. Please make those corrections in your scores.

A brief rehearsal has been scheduled at the end of the lunch time (1:00 to 1:15) in the gym for **all** ringers, using Capital City Ringers' tables and bells on the center front row, Edgewood UCC's on the second row, and Westwood UMC's on the third row. Please be on time!

The primary rehearsal time for those making up Choirs 2 and 3 will be during the final massed rehearsal in the repertoire reading classroom. Choir 2 at 2:15 and Choir 3 at 2:50. There will be no announcement – just go when you need to.

We will then combine all three “choirs” at 3:55 p.m. sharp in the gym, so please be in your concert dress before then. We will have about 10-15 minutes to go through it together again, and that's it! Thanks for participating. It will be fun!
