We have been enjoying the latest addition to our bass bells, the C#2, which we purchased last March and received just in time for our spring concerts. Unbeknownst to her until our Lansing concerts, this bell was dedicated to Jane Wright in honor of her founding of CCR and directing for 31 years. The acquisition of the C#2 allowed us to complete **7** octaves of handbells! We plan to buy the lower 7th octave handchimes (C2 to F#2) at a cost of about \$6800. Fall 2014 included a challenging mix of musical numbers, including *The Sunken Cathedral*, the first piece to demand the use of all six of the large aluminum bells we owned at the time – C2 through F#2. Table space was at a premium! The diverse repertoire also included *Ragtime*, *West Indies Carol* (popularly known as *Mary's Little Boy Child*) and Bach's *Little Fugue*. We welcomed guest artists--violinist Isoa Chapman, flutist Lisa Moore, and CCR's Shannon Spasova on viola.

The season opened with an early local concert at Our Savior Lutheran, which was supposed to be followed the next evening by a retirement center performance, but treacherous weather required a postponement to the spring. We next traveled to Kalamazoo to play at Jane Wright's church, Westwood UMC. We also performed at ringer Lorraine Finison's childhood church, Coopersville Reformed. Perhaps the highlight of the season was a joint performance with the Lakewood Area Choral Society in Lake Odessa in front of a very large and highly enthusiastic crowd. The season ended with a final concert at Faith Lutheran in Okemos.

During the concerts, the audience was entertained between pieces by Rich Weingartner, the Voice of CCR, as he shared a series of letters to Santa from various ringers. Items on the Christmas wish lists ranged from world peace to fuzzy pink bunny slippers. In the end, CCR was blessed with the appreciative and enthusiastic audiences that were at the top of all of our lists.

Here's to You, Jane!

CCR's spring term was a tribute to our founder and artistic director, Jane Wright. After 31 years of directing CCR, a group she created in 1984, Jane decided to spend more time with her three grandkids and less time commuting from Kalamazoo to Lansing for rehearsals and concerts. During the program, audiences were regaled with stories of Jane's history and some of her favorite CCR stories, like the time she had to recruit audience members to sightread music at a concert after a car full of CCR members got lost on the way!

Jane wasn't easy on the group in her final term. The repertoire, a collection of Jane's personal favorites, included some of the most challenging pieces CCR has ever played, including *Tempest* and *Stoccato on 'Alice Ralston'*. The audience was treated to Kim Finison's beautiful ukulele accompaniment to *Ashokan Farewell*, and Jane provided accompaniment of her own on the final song, playing clarinet on *When the Saints Go Marching In*, after passing the baton to her successor, Nicole Leppala, so she could direct. Several guest artists participated in the Lansing concerts, including violinist Isoa Chapman, trombonist Dick Brown, clarinetist/saxophonist Doug Gluckin, and tuba player Ed Mallett.

The season opened with performances at Lyons-Muir Church in Muir, St. Peter Lutheran in Macomb, and First Presbyterian in Fenton. The Macomb performance was a joint concert with *Bellissima!*, another handbell ensemble directed by Jane's long-time friend, Hazel Lawrence. Among the collaborations during this concert was a performance of all three pieces from former *Bellissima!* ringer Judy Phillips' *Triptych*. Following the tour, CCR entertained seniors with a concert at Burcham Hills Retirement Center in East Lansing.

CCR's local concerts were at Plymouth Congregational and Delta Presbyterian. The season ended with a special concert at Mt. Hope United Methodist, CCR's rehearsal home for the last 31 years. In her final remarks to the audience, Jane noted that it was fitting that she was ending her career with CCR in the very church where she first began directing handbells so very long ago. All our best to you, Jane! We love you!

As we gave a fond farewell to Jane Wright last spring, we welcomed our new music director, Nicole Leppala! Nicole has been the music director at Hope Lutheran in DeWitt, Michigan, since 2000.
