Sounds from the American West and Beyond

In the spring of 2017, CCR hit the ground running with two concerts in early February. First, we performed at the United Church of Big Rapids as part of the Big Rapids Festival of the Arts. A week later we performed at First Congregational UCC of Battle Creek as part of their winter concert series. Then, in April, we attended the Handbell Musicians of America Area 5 Festival at the Lansing Center, then concluded the season with a more traditional performance schedule of concerts at Faith United Methodist in Coleman, Delta Retirement Center in Lansing, Okemos Community Church, and Our Savior Lutheran in Delta Township.

The season's theme was "Sounds from the American West and Beyond." Most, but not all, of the selections had a clear association with the western motif. A medley of *Buffalo Gals, The Western Home,* and *She'll Be Comin' Around the Mountain* was led by guest conductor Laura Sparks and gave our director, Nicole Leppala, a chance to perform on the other side of the bell tables. *William Tell Overture* recalled childhood memories of the Lone Ranger, while *Song at Sunrise* featured our Melissa Klamer on flute. Rick Hobrla tried his hand at arranging music with an arrangement of *The Good, the Bad, and the Ugly.* The song concluded with what is likely the very first fatality ever recorded resulting from a handbell duel. We closed with a rousing version of the theme from the *The Magnificent Seven.*
