#### We're Recording a CD!

On Saturday, May 18, we spent the day in the recording studio laying down the tracks from our audience-pleasing spring concerts, *Pop, Rock, and All That Jazz!* It was an exhausting day, made even more so by the fact that everything had to be hauled up to (and later, down from) the third-floor recording studio in a mansion near the Lansing Country Club.

Many of you know how much equipment we have, and it's pretty much all heavy! No elevator, of course! Needless to say, we hired some wonderful help so we wouldn't be too tired to play! It all worked out very well.

The editing and post-production process will take awhile, but we hope to have the CD ready by the time of our spring concerts. We know you will enjoy it!

## Ringing in the Season

The title of our 2017 holiday concert season was inspired by an original piece in our repertoire, Winter Carillon, composed by Mitchell Eithun, one of two new CCR ringers last fall, and it made extensive use of CCR's large aluminum bells. The repertoire featured many Christmas standards, including It Came Upon the Midnight Clear, The Holly and the Ivy, and Still, Still, Still. Between pieces, narrator Rich Weingartner entertained audiences with candid advice for beginning handbell ringers and little known (or perhaps well-known) secrets from the Handbell Ringers Code of Ethics. The grand finale of each concert was a thundering rendition of Trans-Siberian Orchestra's Wizards in Winter.

The travel schedule for the season featured three local concerts bracketed by longer trips. CCR's first performance was at Faith United Methodist Church in Coleman (northeast of Mt. Pleasant). The next performance was at University Lutheran Church in East Lansing. In an accident of timing, the concert started just prior to a Michigan State University basketball game down the street at the Breslin Center. Afterwards, MSU basketball coach Tom Izzo complained to CCR that our concert cut into the attendance at his game! Next up were concerts at St. James Catholic Church in Mason and Asbury United Methodist Church in Lansing. The season ended with a private performance for the Grand Rapids First Assembly in Wyoming, Michigan.

# Pop, Rock, and All That Jazz!

The CCR concert theme for the spring of 2018 was *Pop, Rock, and All That Jazz!* The repertoire had a modern feel and lent itself to lots of accompaniment from keyboard, bass guitar, and particularly drums. The show opened with the song that inspired our title, *All That Jazz* from the Broadway hit, *Chicago*. Also included were hits from the 1950s right up to 2016 which were originally recorded by well-known musical acts such as Frank Sinatra, the Beatles, the Beach Boys, Leonard Cohen, ABBA, and Coldplay. Two of the numbers, *City of Stars* and *Hallelujah*, featured our guest vocalist, Carly Mossner. The program climaxed with tie-dyed gloves and a rousing version of *Dancing Queen*.

While the repertoire was demanding, the travel schedule was not. The season opened with concerts at Faith Lutheran Church in Okemos and Central United Methodist Church in downtown Lansing. Next up was a concert at our most distant venue, Lyons-Muir Church in Muir. We closed the season at Hope Lutheran Church in DeWitt, but before that, CCR performed a fascinating joint concert with the DeWitt Community Concert Band (also directed by CCR's director, Nicole Leppala) and the MSU Community Music School Jazz Band. Since CCR ringer Kim Finison also plays trumpet in both of the other musical groups, he got no rest and was one tired puppy at the end of the night!

Shari Dann (a.k.a. No-bell Prize) joined CCR at the middle of the Spring 2018 season to replace a ringer who had to leave the group suddenly. That was a big challenge, but she was equal to the task!
